

Make your own soap!

Easy, step-by-step instructions

Step #1



Cut the soap base into 1-2" cubes and put into a microwave-safe bowl.

Step #2



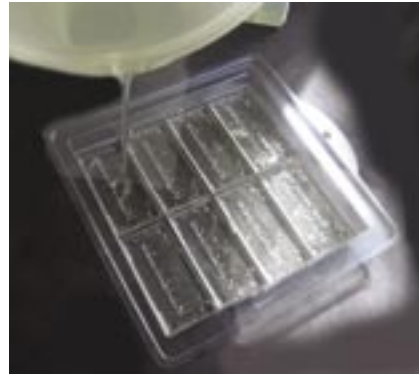
Heat in the microwave in 30-second intervals, stirring between each interval until the base has completely melted.

Step #3



Add fragrances or dyes to the melted mixture if you would like. Stir until the fragrance is fully incorporated and doesn't look cloudy. Start with .25 ounce of fragrance per pound of base used. If you prefer you can just add the fragrance a few drops at a time until you get the strength of fragrance you desire. If you are using a colorant add 1/8 a teaspoon into the base and stir.

Step #4



Pour the soap base into the soap mold. Some people like to spray the top with rubbing alcohol to avoid bubbles appearing in the soap as it dries. You can add just a little soap base for smaller bars or up to 2 lbs. of base in the mold for 4 oz. bars.

Step #5



Within 1-3 hours your soap should be hardened and ready to pop out of the soap mold! Use and enjoy.
